Information

- The information is not easily available from other searches
- Reviewers make every attempt to ensure that the information is free of errors
- The content is objective, and not politically, religiously or otherwise biased
- The information has sufficient scope to cover the topic
- Sponsorship is clearly identified and advertising is minimal
- The necessary disclaimers and privacy statements are posted
- Chat rooms and message boards are reviewed for inappropriate exchanges

And all the information is professionally annotated and cataloged — providing "at a glance" assurance that retrieved results match your search criteria.

Timeliness

- The site is updated frequently
- The site shows the date of the most recent update or the dating of the information

Links

- Links are relevant, appropriate and functional
- At gateway sites, links are checked for content
