### School and Community

Roswell High School is a part of the Roswell Independent School District. The location is in the southern part of Roswell, in South East New Mexico, which places the school in the lower income portion of the city of Roswell. The school was constructed in 1953 and has gone through several renovations and additions to accommodate population growth, new technologies, expanded programs and curriculum, and an atmosphere more conducive to the educational process.

Roswell High School is privileged to have a large number of community assets that add to the services of Roswell High School can provide to the students. These include Department of Workforce Solutions, La Casa Behavioral Health, Assurance Home, Sunrise (ENMMC), and many others.

Within our district there are 12 Elementary Schools, 1 Early Literacy School, 4 Middle Schools, 2 traditional High Schools, 1 Alternative High School and 1 Early College High School. Roswell High is currently the largest school in the district with 1400+ students enrolled for the 20/21 school year.

### Academic Rigor

**Honors.** Roswell High School currently offers 7 courses as Honors: Biology, English 9, English 10, Ceramics & Pottery, Spanish 3, World History & Geography, and Human Anatomy & Physiology.

**Pre-Ap.** We currently offer 7 courses as Pre-Ap: Algebra 1, Algebra 2, Chemistry, Drama & Stagecraft, Geometry, Pre-Calculus and Music Theory.

**AP.** Roswell High School offers 12 courses as AP: English Language & Composition, English Literature & Composition, Environmental Science, Physics, Studio Art 2D Design, Macro Economics, US Government, Spanish 4 Language and Culture, Spanish 5 Literature, Statistics, US History, Capstone Seminar, Capstone Research.

**Dual Credit.** Roswell High School partners with ENMU-R and currently has 105 students enrolled in 31 dual credit classes.

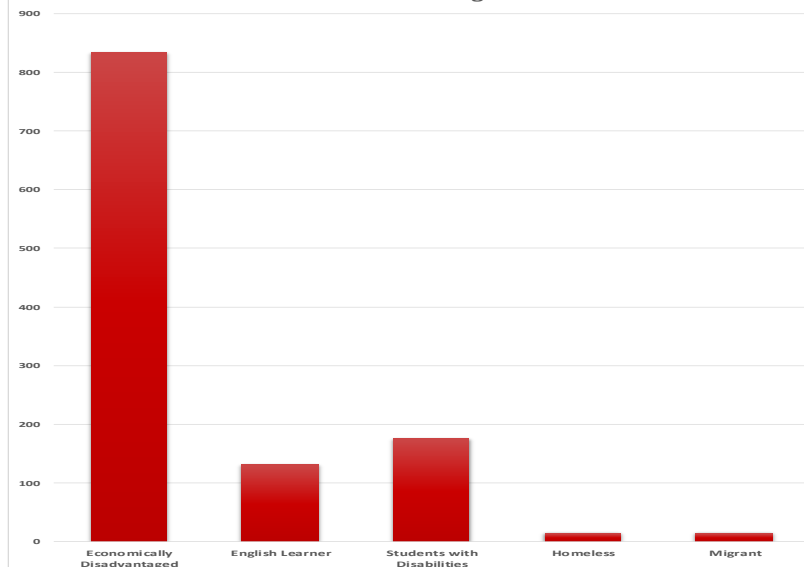

### General School Information:

Roswell High School currently offers 7 Career Pathways for their students: Agriculture Mechanics, Animal Science, Art, Automated Engineering, Automotive Technology, Computer Informatics and Culinary Arts. Our students can also be part of Band, Choir or Orchestra for all 4 years through academic classes and after school activities. For sports, we currently have Basketball (boys and girls), Baseball, Cheer, Cross Country, Dance, Golf, Football, Softball, Tennis, Track, Soccer (boys and girls), Volleyball, and Wrestling teams. Roswell High is currently a 5A school within NM, but for football we are 4A.

Our school day is split into a hybrid block with periods running 90 minutes. Students are scheduled for 8 classes a year and attend 4 classes a day, with the split being Odds and Even periods. Students have the opportunity to earn 8 full credits a school year (4 each semester). Our district requires 28 credits for graduation.
